

Cryptanthus zonatus, bivittatus

krip-TAN-thus zo-NAH-tus, bih-vee-TAY-tuss

Common Names: Earth's Stars, Star Fish Plant, Zebra Plant,

Family: Bromeliaceae

Origin: Brazil

Growth: Clumping, compact

Light: Bright, filtered

Foot Candles: 100 - 200

Water: Keep evenly moist

Humidity: 60% - 90%

Temperature: 13°C - 32°C

Soil: Well draining potting mix

Container: Terrarium, living wall

Nutrients: 10-10-10 Monthly

Propagation: Seed or removal of offsets

Interiorscape Use: Reception, living walls, employee personal plant

Common Pests: Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

Common Issues: Root rot when sitting in water. Will lose colour with low light.

Comments: Dozens of interesting colour patterns available. Relatively slow growing. Newly formed leaves will be small with low humidity and light levels.

Toxicity: Safe.
